

- The results of the evaluation must be: (1) used to refine, improve, and strengthen the program and to refine the performance measures; and (2) made available to the public upon request.
- Grantees working with their SEAs, must evaluate the academic progress of children participating in the 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC program.
- Data from Needs assessment, Native Star, data collection tools can be used to measure progress and for other reports required for the 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC program.

#### **Program Evaluation**

- \$2,500.00 will be released to all schools that have submitted all required reports.
- Purpose: Support schools in securing an external evaluator who will assist with evaluations, compiling and submitting evaluation reports.
- Funds should be expended by <u>June 1, 2019</u>

### Requirements

- Schools must submit a spending plan.
- Spending Plan submission deadline is December 21, 2018
- To ensure quality evaluation services, schools will secure the services of a highly qualified external evaluator to evaluate the 21st CCLC Program.
- The external evaluator should not be an employee of the school or a former employee of the school.
- School will provide evidence of qualification of the external evaluator
- School Administrator Signatures are required
