It is time for each high school program to contact those students who exited from their school during school year 2011-2012. The deadline to complete the data collection and submit to BIE-Division of Performance and Accountability (DPA) is **Friday, October 11, 2013**.

Also, the BIE-DPA will report the data in Indicator 14 of the BIE Annual Performance Report.
