On April 1 and April 13, 2015, I sent you letters informing you about Tribal Consultations to discuss the American Indian Education Study Group (Study Group) *Blueprint for Reform* and Secretarial Order 3334 to Restructure the Bureau of Indian Education (BIE) announcing four onsite consultations and one webinar.

Following these announcements, I received requests from tribal constituents for a tribal consultation in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Due to the exceptional circumstances to meet the requests of these tribal leaders, an additional consultation session is scheduled in less than 30 days as per the consultation policy.
