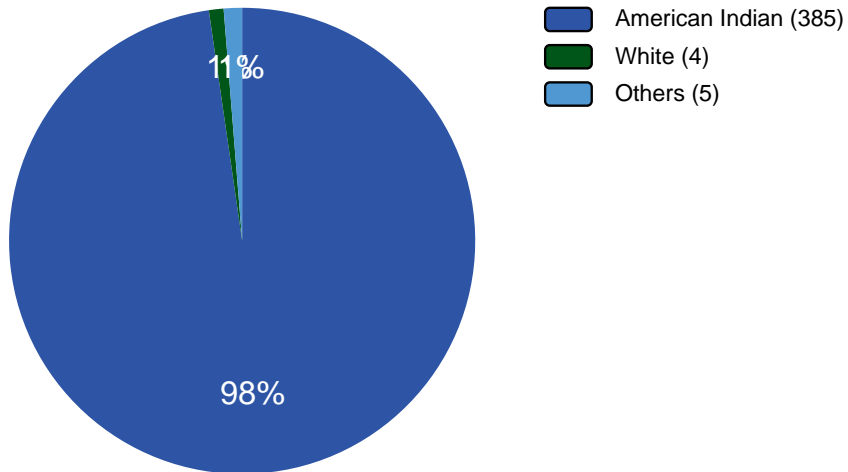

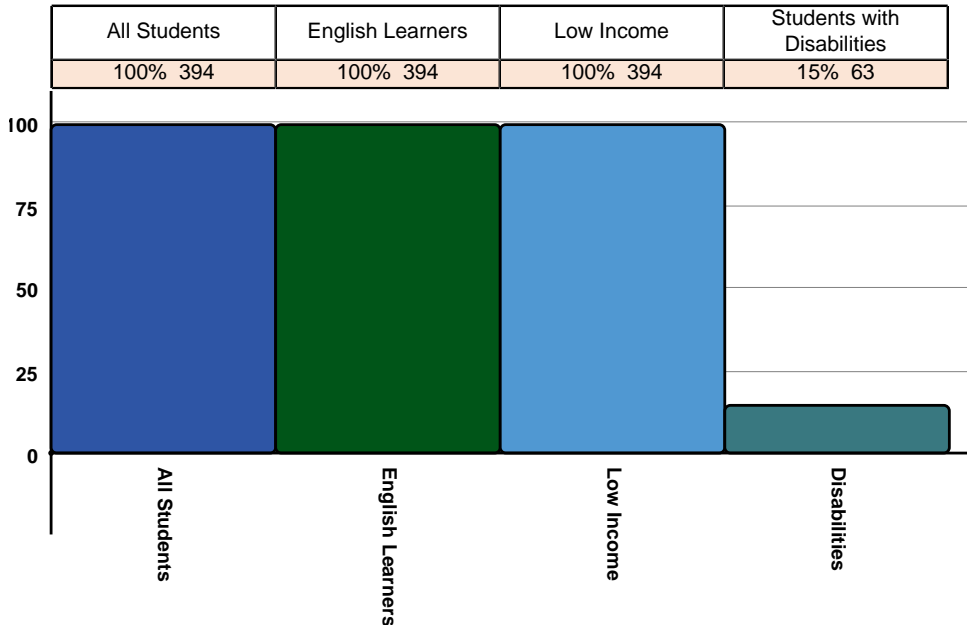

Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity



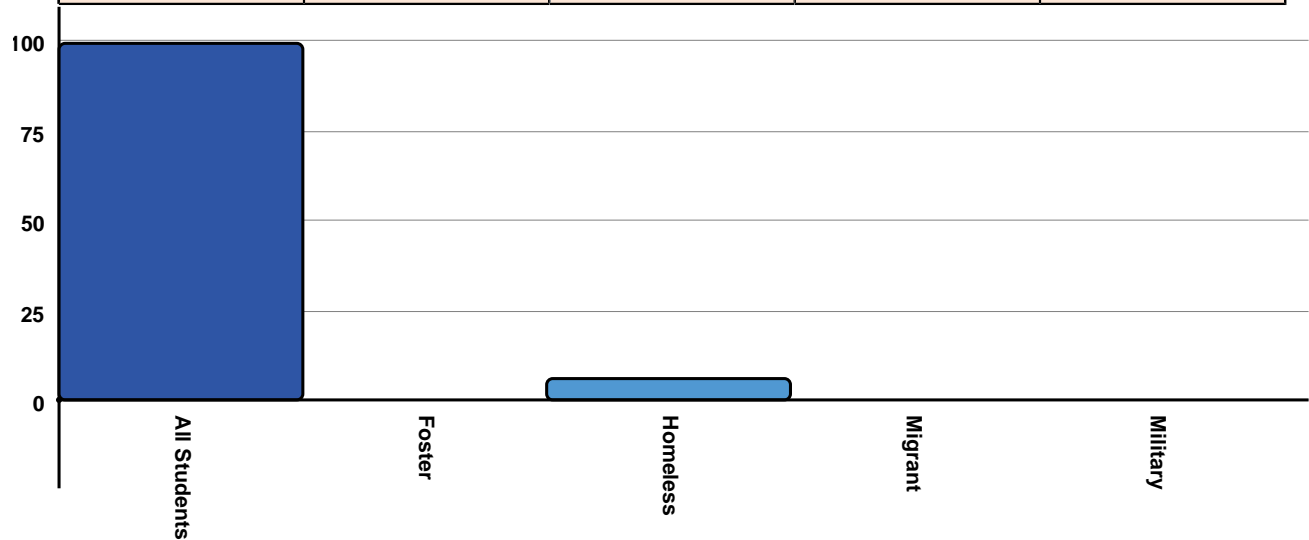

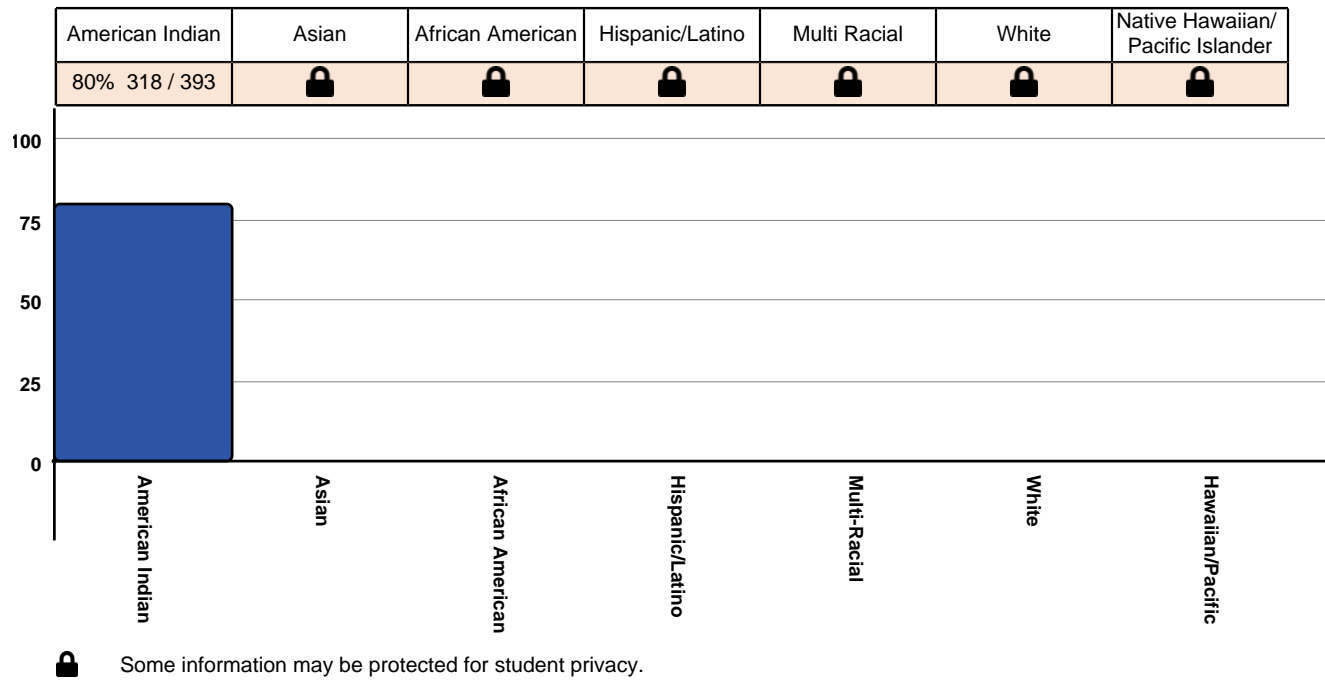

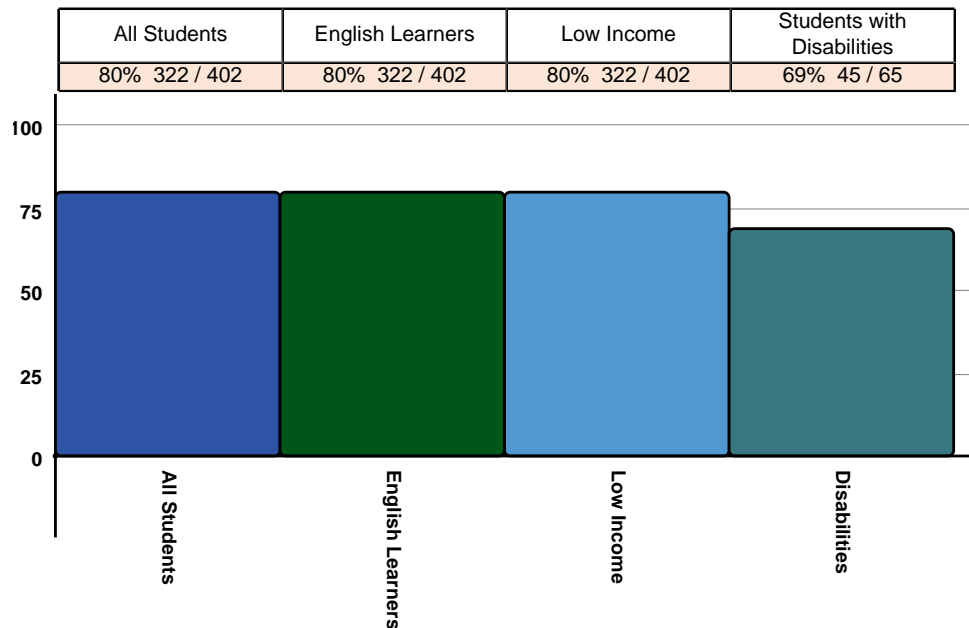

On Track Attendance by Race/Ethnicity

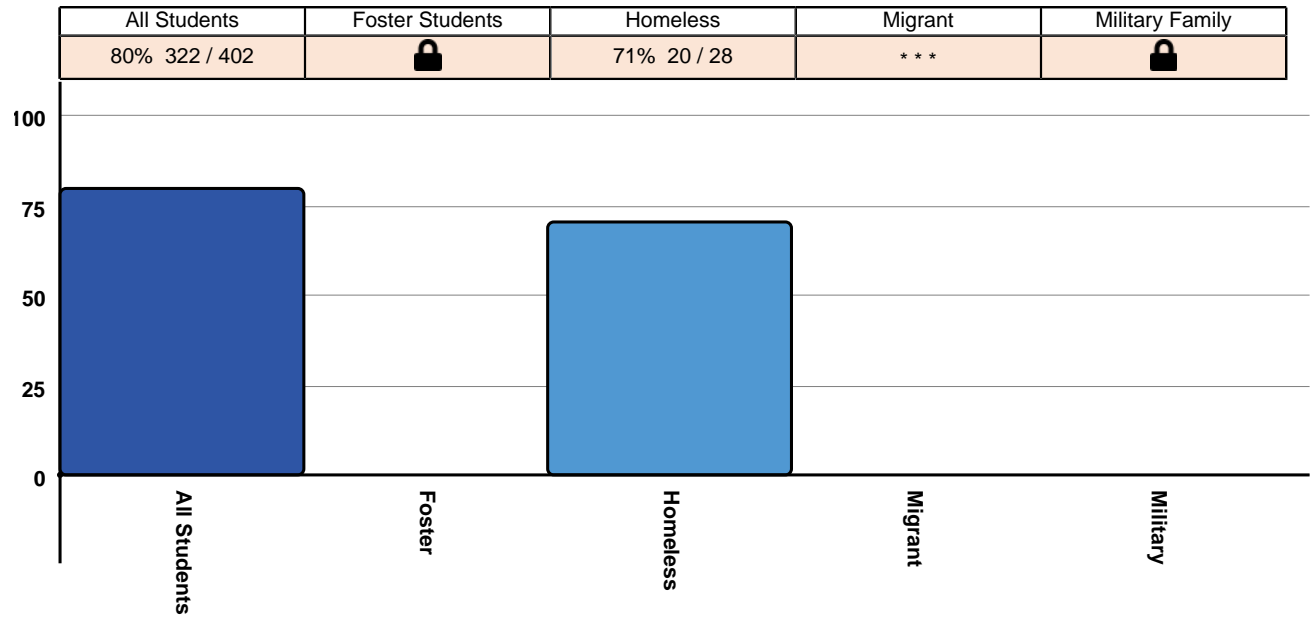


On Track Attendance by Other Characteristics

On Track Attendance by Residence



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On-track attendance shares the percentage of students who are not chronically absent. Students must be present and ready to learn to succeed academically. Chronically absent students are those students who are absent for any reason (excused or unexcused), such as illness or out-of-school suspension, for 10% or more of a school's total school time between October 1 and May 31. School Year is represented by the last year of the school year. For example, the 2020-2021 school year is shown as 2021

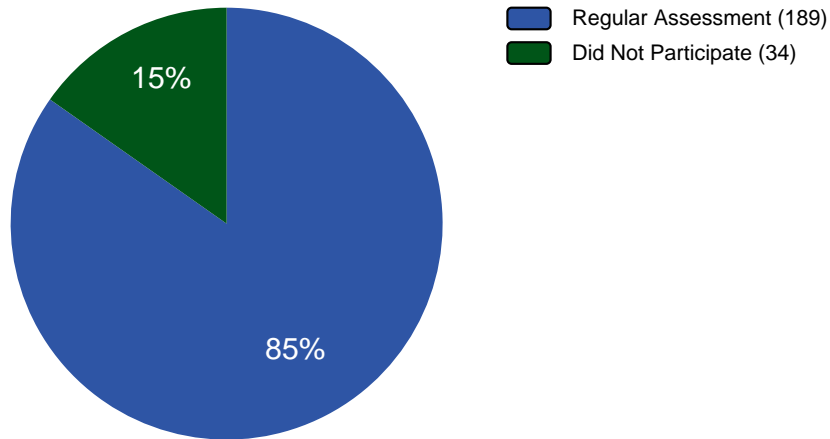

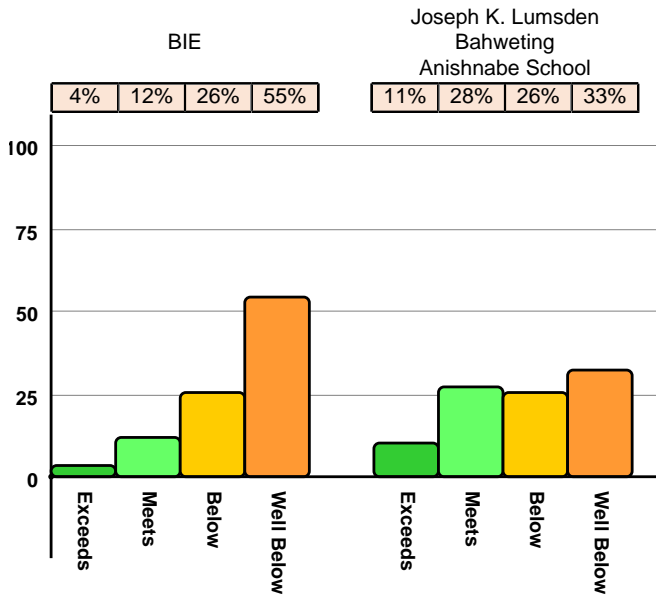

84.75% of students participated in the English Language Arts Assessment. The goal is 95% or higher.

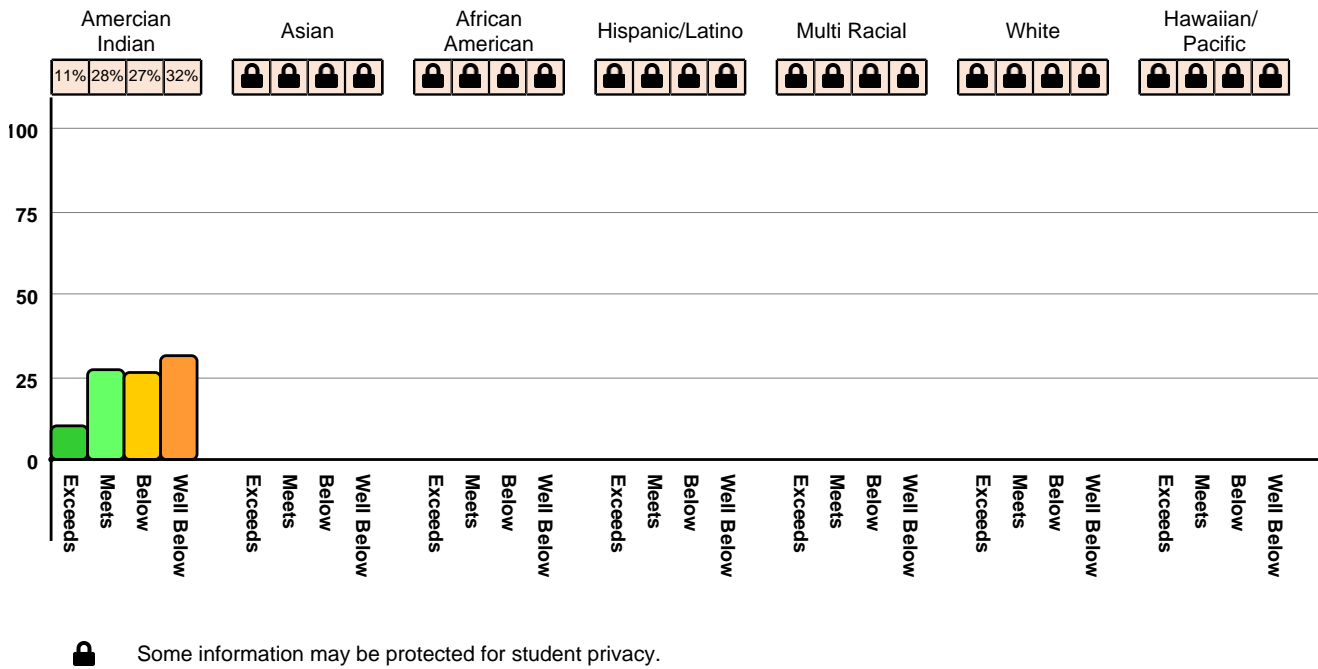
English Language Arts Proficiency - All Students



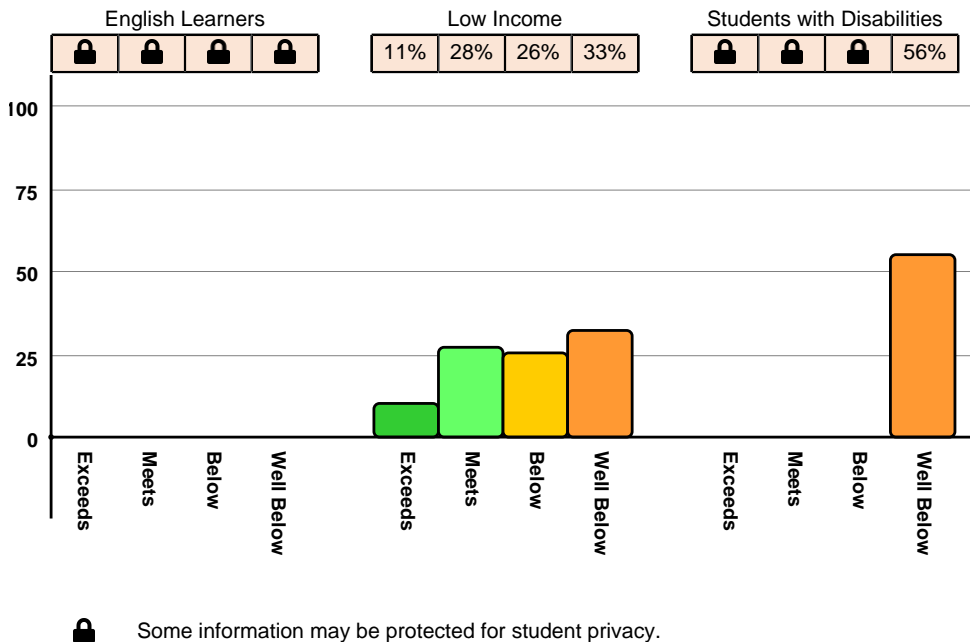
40.21% of students in this school demonstrated proficiency on this assessment by scoring in the "Meets" or "Exceeds" category. That is above BIE average of 17.18%.

English Language Arts Proficiencies by Race/Ethnicity

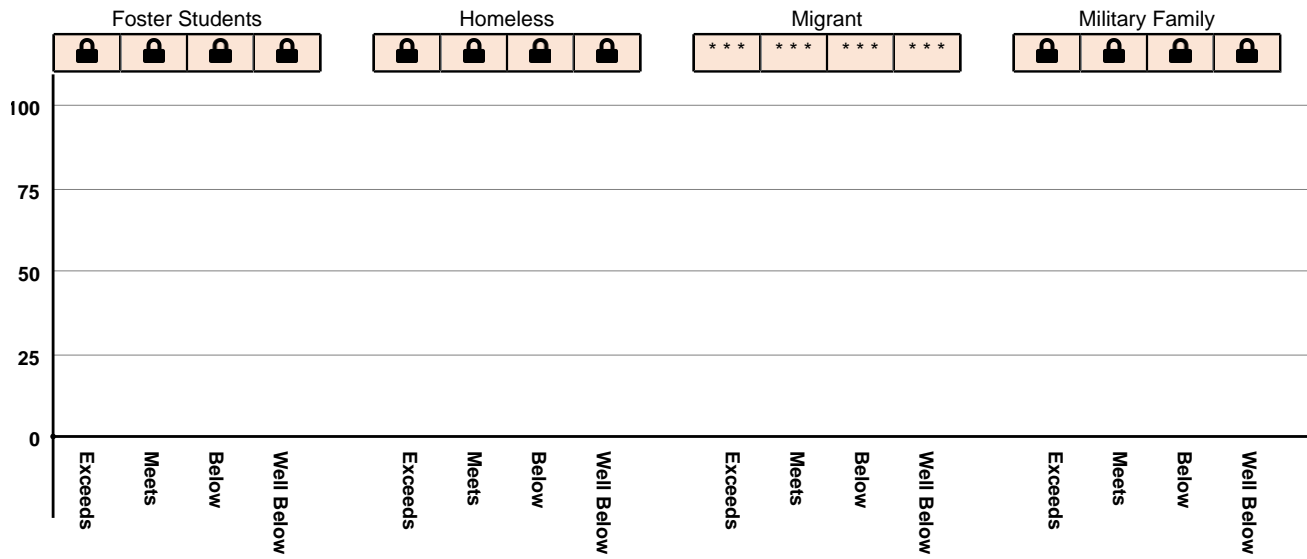


English Language Arts Proficiencies by Other Characteristics

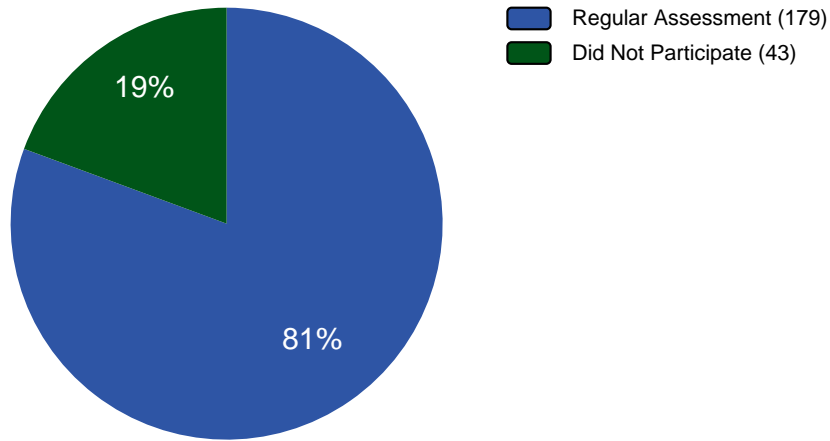

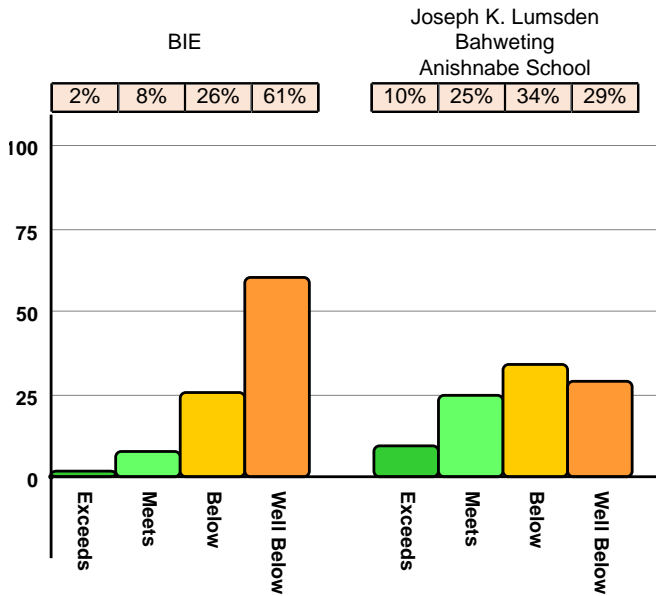

80.63% of students participated in the Mathematics Assessment. The goal is 95% or higher.

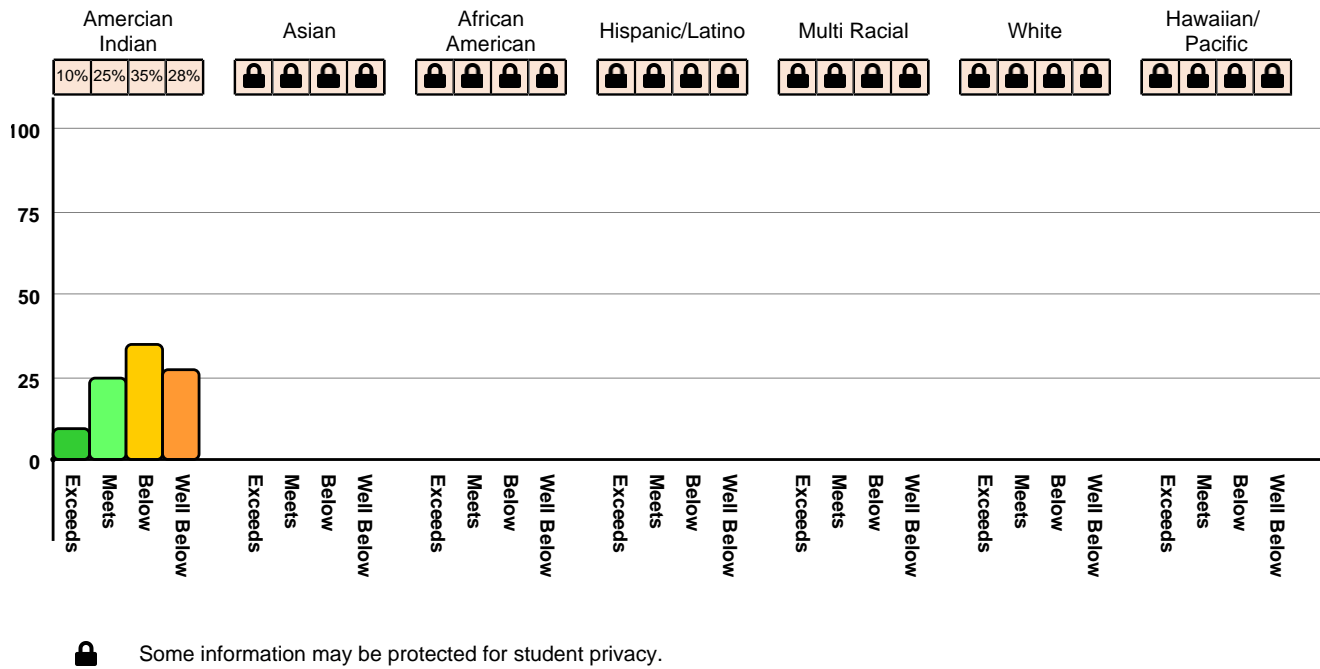
Mathematics Proficiency - All Students



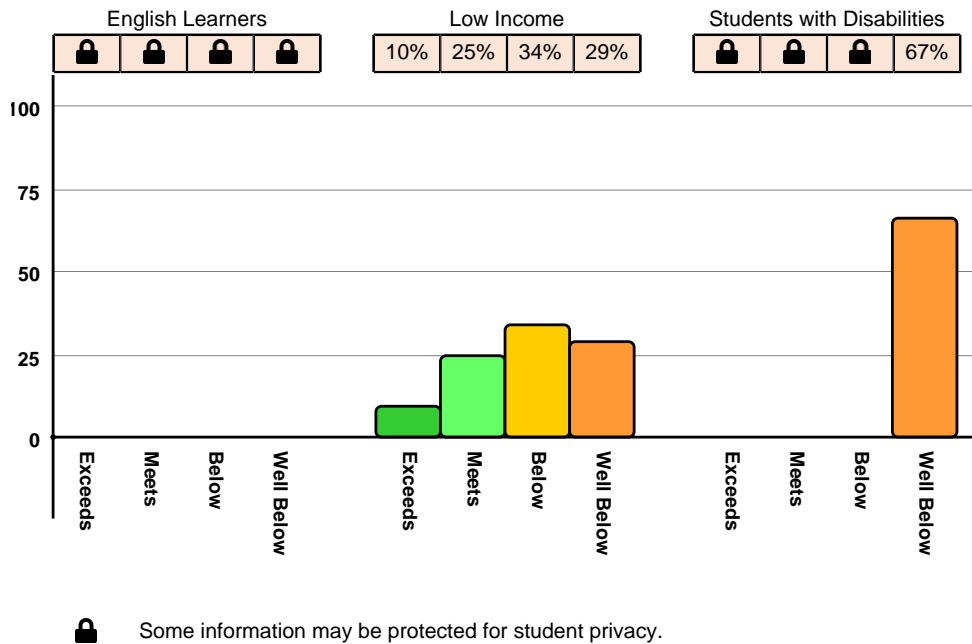
35.75% of students in this school demonstrated proficiency on this assessment by scoring in the "Meets" or "Exceeds" category. That is above BIE average of 10.78%.

Mathematics Proficiencies by Race/Ethnicity

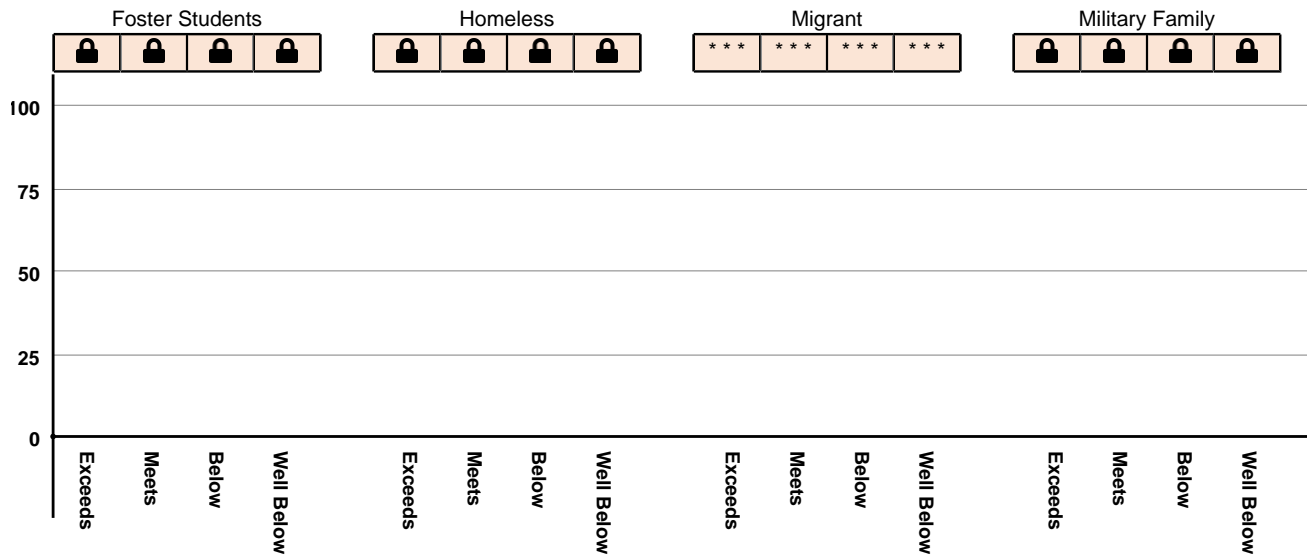



Mathematics by Other Characteristics
